## **Call for Delegate Coordinators**

Delegate coordinators serve a three-year term and must meet one of the following requirements to be considered for the position:

- Agriculture education teacher
- Teacher educator at the postsecondary level
- · Exceptional knowledge of FFA (including current facilitators of National FFA programs/former National FFA Officers, etc.)
